Instructions to Voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting as an absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. See the end of ballot for initials.

IMPORTANT: It is recommended to use an official ballot marking pen available at your polling place or a #2 pencil.

Instructions to Voters

If you make a mistake on your ballot, please ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: ask the municipal clerk.)

Write a name on the ballot, with an arrow next to the name.

Write a name that is not on the ballot as a "write-in" and complete the line. Write the name like _____.
