### **Fiber (Paper and Cardboard):**

Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books, Letterhead, Envelopes, Standard Forms, Computer Print-Outs, Copy Paper, Junk Mail, Corrugated cardboard, shoe boxes, cereal boxes, soda or beer containers, paper egg cartons, clean pizza boxes. **Break down and flatten cardboard or place in paper bags.**

### **Co-mingled:**

**Plastic, Glass, Metal & Aluminum  
Cans:**

**Containers** – Rinse all containers – remove caps from containers and labels from tin cans. Plastic containers #1-#9.

## Iron County Ordinance No. 2101

Occupants of single family and 2 to 4 unit residences shall separate and properly prepare recyclables and take to any of the municipal recycling drop-off collection sites in Iron County during the assigned hours of said drop-off sites, only when an attendant is on duty.

Violation of any Section of the Ordinance shall be punishable by a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more than \$300 for each offense. Each day that a violation occurs or continues shall be deemed a separate offense. Second and subsequent offenses within one (1) year shall be punishable by a forfeiture of not less than \$300 nor more than \$700 for each offense.

## Responsibilities of Owners of Multiple- Family Dwellings

- ✓ Provide adequate, separate containers for the recyclable materials;
- ✓ Notify tenants, in writing, at the time of renting or leasing the dwelling and at least semi-annually thereafter about the established recycling program;
- ✓ Provide for the collection of the materials separated from the solid waste by the tenants and the delivery of the materials to a recycling facility;
- ✓ Notify tenants of reasons to Reduce and Recycle solid waste, which materials are collected, how to prepare the materials in order to meet the processing requirements, collection methods or sites, locations and hours of operation, and a contact person or company, including a name, address and telephone number.

## Responsibilities of Owners of Non- Residential Facilities & Properties

- ✓ Provide adequate, separate containers for the recyclable materials;
- ✓ Notify, in writing, at least semi-annually, all users, tenants, and occupants of the property about the established recycling program;
- ✓ Provide for the collection of the materials separated from the solid waste by the users, tenants, and occupants, and the delivery of the materials to a recycling facility;
- ✓ Notify users, tenants, and occupants of the reasons to Reduce and Recycle, which materials are collected, how to prepare materials in order to meet the processing requirements, collection methods or sites, locations and hours of operation, and a contact person or company, including a name, address, and telephone number.
